


AutoInvoice:

Egypt E-Invoicing Add-On for SAP




Modifications needed in your SAP system to Adhere to Government Regulations

For the objective of accelerating the digital transformation in Egypt, the Egyptian Tax Authority (ETA) decided to gradually enforce the adoption of Electronic Invoicing across business to improve tax control, and reduce fraud and tax evasion. E-Invoicing is the system used by companies to submit their issued invoices to the Tax Authority, and get notified on events related to their document issuance.

AutoInvoice Add-On for Egypt by ECS

AutoInvoice is an SAP Add-On by ECS developed in ABAP language to facilitate the digital processing of invoices between companies and the Egyptian Government. The solution converts the invoices in the SAP System into E-Invoices and allows submission to Egyptian Tax Authority (ETA) directly from the SAP® ECC or SAP® S/4HANA systems.

Save Time

End-to-End integration with SAP ECC and SAP S/4HANA

AutoInvoice Add-on integrates the SAP ERP with the ETA E-Invoicing System. This will automate the task of issuing and receipt of all invoices.

Generate E-Invoice

Generation of an e-invoice/UUID takes place in real-time.

Cancel E-Invoice

You can cancel the invoice reference number for various reasons like incorrect entry, duplicate entry etc.

Receive Notifications

AutoInvoice will allow you to receive notifications on document related events - validation, issuance, rejection and cancellation.

Validation


You can perform validation checks for the issued invoices before you submit it to ensure the data meets the specifications of the tax authorities.

Reporting

The solution helps generate reports on all e-invoices generated.

Quick to deploy

The implementation time line takes 1 week but can vary significantly depending on the requirements.



Egyptian e-invoicing: SAP ERP Integration Process

The above figure is declared by the Egyptian Tax Authorities to explain the steps to integrate the taxpayer's ERP solution with the Government e-invoicing system.

Integration Process

According to the new Egyptian regulation that was announced in March 2020, all businesses must send electronic tax invoices to the tax Authorities. It means that suppliers need to send issued invoices to the Egyptian Tax authorities (ETA) before the customer receives it. This will enable the (ETA) to have a real-time information about taxpayer invoices. The integration between the SAP ERP system and the government e-invoicing system is based on available APIs for various purposes.


E-Invoicing Requirements in Egypt

- As a first step, Companies must register with the tax office to obtain their credentials and access the APIs.
- Companies must make changes to their existing SAP ERP to integrate with Tax E-Invoicing system. ECS AutoInvoice Addon covers all the changes that is needed to adhere to the government requirements.
- Companies are required to issue electronic tax invoices which include the electronic signature and a unified code for each good and service. These electronic tax invoices must be approved by the Egyptian Tax Authority.
- The invoice format is ISON or XML.
- All invoices must include a Unique ID (UUID) code.
- Supplier's Products/items should be classified and mapped with the schema field prescribed by the government according to the Global Product Classification (GPC).
- The invoice issued by SAP System must cover all the mandatory fields stipulated by the Egyptian Tax Authority.




Integration Process

In order to synchronize data between the company's SAP ERP and the tax authorities systems, there should be integration that allows the communication and data flow from the ERP to the Egypt Tax System. For this purpose, there are APIs which enable users to simply complete the submission of the E-invoice from within their SAP ERP. This AutoInvoice Addon also communicates back any notifications from the Egypt Tax System to the SAP ERP. By automating this process, the business will be more efficient and will eliminate manual efforts and time consumption in uploading data from the ERP.
